Scholarships will be presented pending evaluations by a committee of the Alumni of the Class of 1968. Recipients of the scholarships awarded will be notified by the SHS counselor by May 1, 2019. The actual scholarship amount is a one time amount delivered to the approved institution and is to be used toward educational expenses. Proof of enrollment and completion of the first semester of studies should be submitted to the *Alumni of Class of 1968* by December 20, 2019. The student must maintain at least a 2.0 average while completing at least 12 semester hours. If the student does not choose to attend the indicated institution, the award will be forfeited and should be returned to the Class of 1968 Alumni group.
